Family Stay Tiwi way Tarntipi Bush Camp

You book and pay transfers.

What we will provide:

- Tiwi Cultural Educators, activities led by Mr Teddy Portaminni
- Camp site fees, permits and accommodation.
- Administration, activities & coordination of local logistics
- Transport to & from Tarntipi Bush Camp from Wurrumiyanga
- Catering for breakfast; tea, coffee, milk, sugar

What you bring:

- Your own food for lunch and dinner
- Medium size back pack
- Sleeping bag
- Torch (a head light is handy)
- Toiletries
- Towel
- Wide brim hat
- Thongs
- Swimming togs (optional)
- Long sleeve shirt (for nights)
- Loose fitting t-shirts
- Loose long shorts
- Water bottle
- Medication (as prescribed/needed – please let the group facilitator know)
- Sunscreen
- Mosquito repellent

Mobile phones for emergency use only at camp site.

There is internet and mobile phone reception at township of Wurrumiyanga.

Camping facilities:

- A Bush camp site 20 minute drive from town (Wurrumiyanga)
- Tents with mattresses, sheets and pillows. Or sleep under stars option.
- Bush shower (dependent on water availability)
- Drop toilets
- Kitchen/Cooking area (campfire with camp ovens and fire grill cooking)
- Engel fridge to put your cold food in
- Solar power

Visits to some local Tiwi agencies in Wurrumiyanga such as the Museum and Tiwi Design are possible, but these agencies are only open on weekdays. The museum has a \$10 cash entry fee per adult.

You will be met at the ferry landing in Wurrumiyanga (or airport) by your driver and vehicle. The vehicle is a white Troopy 4WD with the sign TARNTIPI BUSH CAMP on the side.
